- \* The General Scholarship fund provides for up to 50% of the registration/tuition fee.
- \* The Lineworker and APPA scholarship funds provide for 100% registration/tuition fees.
- \* The MEAN Scholarship Program funding does not cover such expenses as travel, meals and lodging.
- \* Qualifying scholarships must be related to the electric utility industry.
- \* A sample of approved programs appears on the reverse side of this application.
- \* Scholarship funds must be used within one year from date of the award. If the awarded funds are not used within one year, the funds must be returned to MEAN.

## **Municipal Energy Agency of Nebraska Scholarship Application**

### **Training options include:**

#### **Utility-Related:**

- Line worker training approved training facility
- Line worker correspondence course 4-year course
- Power plant operator training power plant training programs sponsored by NMPP Energy or by your state utility section/association
- Refresher utility course *Meter schools* 2 and 3-day line worker schools
- Safety training Safety training programs sponsored by NMPP Energy or by your state utility section/association

#### **Computer Skills/Office Services:**

• Approved computer skills program; accounting – general training, etc.; municipal Clerk's school/finance school

#### **City and Utility Management:**

• Elected official training; management/supervisory skills – general training

## **Scholarship Program Criteria:**

The following criteria will be used in approving scholarship applications:

- Only Service Schedule M & K communities are eligible for scholarships.
- The maximum amount awarded to any one Service Schedule M and K community for general scholarships is \$500 per fiscal year (April-March).
- The maximum amount awarded to any one Service Schedule M and K community for line worker training is \$1,000 per fiscal year (April-March).
- The maximum amount awarded to any one Service Schedule M and K community for APPA training is \$1,000 per fiscal year (April-March).
- Scholarship funds are available on a first come, first served basis.
- In order to qualify for scholarship funds, the applicant must be a city employee, city official (appointed or elected) or community leader (at discretion of MEAN authorized representative).
- The scholarship fund provides a percentage of the registration or tuition fee requested. The scholarship fund does not cover such expenses as travel, meals, and lodging.

## • Application process

- The application must be received and approved by MEAN **prior** to the training session.
  - Funds awarded may be sent after the training session is held.
- The applicant and an authorized signatory (i.e., clerk, city manager, utility superintendent, or mayor) must sign the application for it to be eligible for consideration.
- o If there is doubt as to whether an applicant's attendance at the training session will benefit the member community, a call will be made to the authorized signatory.
- o If the application is approved, a letter is sent to the applicant along with the awarded scholarship funds and a copy will go to the MEAN representative. If the funds are being sent via ACH, a copy will go to the city clerk as well.
- Scholarship funds must be used within one year of the date the funds are awarded.
  - o If the awarded funds are not used within one year, the funds must be returned to MEAN.
